

## Tidy

An HTML Validator (based on Tidy and OpenSP so just call it "Tidy")

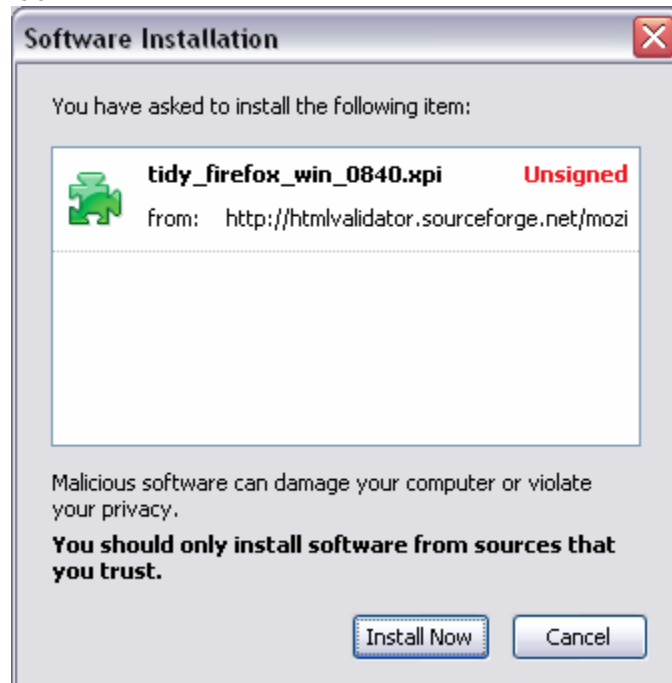
Firefox has a number of valuable tools for use in Web development. One such tool is a code validator that checks for errors in the HTML code that you write.

After installation, an icon sits in the bottom right corner of Firefox and provides a visual signal about errors and warnings in the code of the Web page that you are viewing. It kind be fun to watch the code of the pages around the Web as you browse and can really help you learn about the types of errors that can occur.

If you write any HTML or even if you just want to – try this tool!

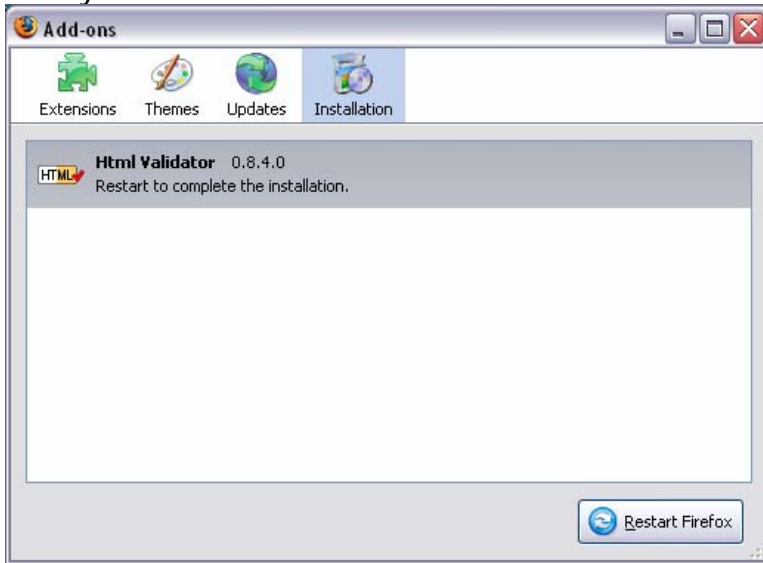
### Installation Instructions

1. Open Firefox
2. Click on the following link:  
<http://users.skynet.be/mgqueury/mozilla/download.html> This will bring you to a "Download" page for this plug-in.
3. [Download HTML Validator for Windows](#) (it is first on the list of versions)
4. You'll see this screen:



When the button becomes available, click the **Install Now** button.

5. Next you'll see this screen:



Click **Restart Firefox** and the installation will be complete. When you reopen Firefox you'll notice a new small icon in the bottom right of the screen. When you mouse-over it, it will give you a small list of errors or warnings if there are any on the page you are viewing. You can click on the icon to get more details.
